

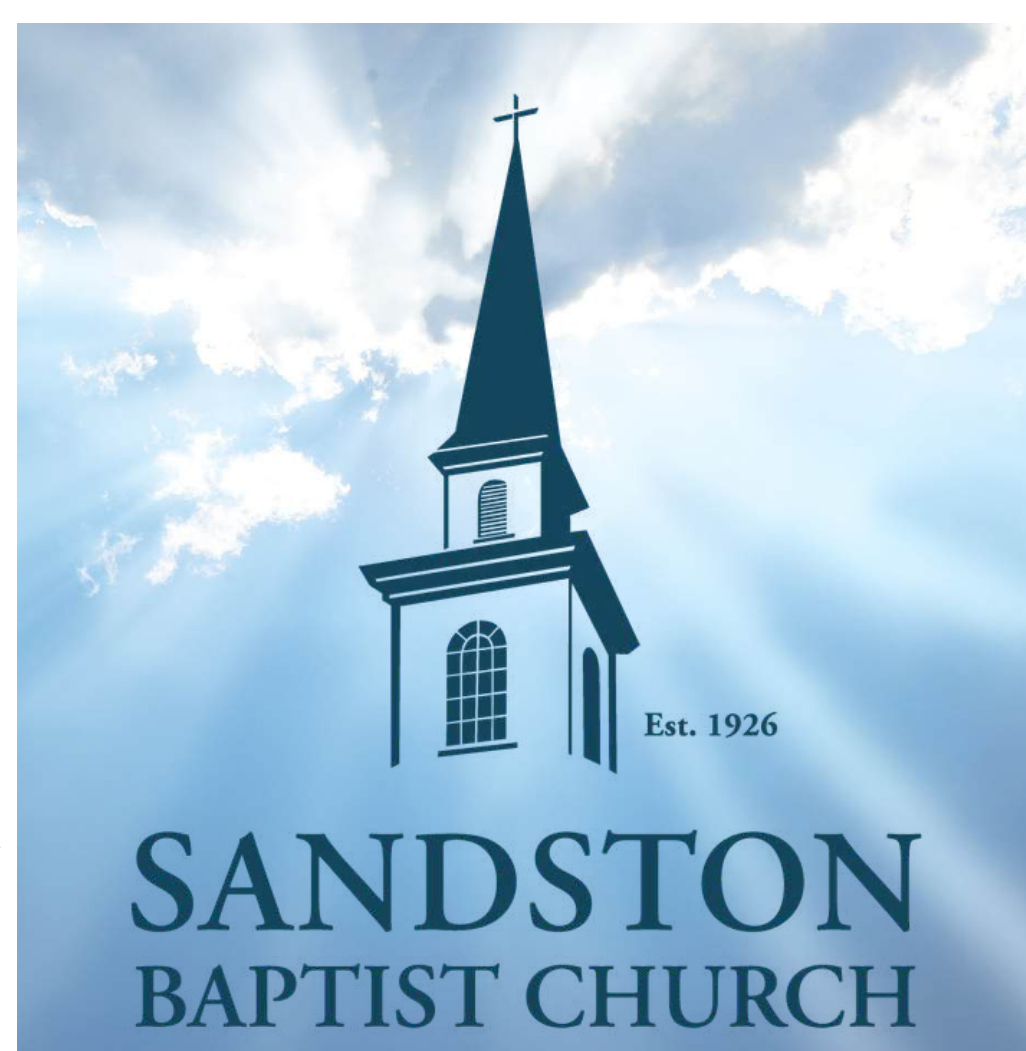


Church ANNOUNCEMENTS
